The European REACH Regulation 1907/2006 on Registration, Evaluation, Authori- zation, and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) entered into force in June 2009 and affects all companies producing, importing, using, or placing products on the Euro- pean market. The aim of the REACH regulation is to ensure a high level of protection of human health and of the environment from chemical substances.

Therefore the requirement in REACH Article 7 (2) to notify ECHA (European Chemical Agency) if a product contains more than 0.1% w/w of an SVHC and tonnage exceeding 1 ton per importer/manufacturer per year is not applicable.
