## **REGULATION (EC) No 1907/2006 (REACH)**

In June 2007, the European Union Regulation concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) was first released. This Regulation established specific duties and obligations for the companies in the European Union (EU) that manufacture or import substances on their own, in preparation, or in articles.

Metrel fully supports the aim of REACH in improving the protection of human health and the environment through the better and earlier identification of the intrinsic properties of chemical substances. As a downstream user, the products of Metrel are non-chemical products that are not designed to release any substances under normal and reasonably predictable application scenarios during their lifespan. Therefore, as per REACH requirements, Metrel products do not need to be registered.

Based on information obtained from our suppliers and our evaluations NO Metrel products and shipping materials contain any of the currently identified substances of very high concern (SVHC) in excess of the 0,1 % (by weight) threshold as listed by the European Chemical Agency (ECHA) under the provision of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006.

Metrel is constantly monitoring the SVHCs, as defined by REACH, in our products. This will be an ongoing process since the complete list of SVHCs will be released in stages.

## **Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS)**

Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) are not intentionally used in the production of the Metrel products. However, possible impurities in trace amounts resulting from raw materials or the manufacturing process and equipment cannot be fully ruled out.

The information is gathered from our raw material suppliers, which is to our present state of knowledge true and accurate at the time and date of this issue. Due to possible changes in the laws and regulations, or other reasons, we cannot guarantee that the status of this product will remain unchanged.
