



PRESENCE OF SUBSTANCES OF VERY HIGH CONCERN IN ARTICLES

The European Union (EU) has adopted regulatory framework for the Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of Chemicals, The Regulation 1907/2006/EC (as REACH). REACH establishes obligations for manufacturers, importers and downstream users of chemical substances imported to or produced in EU.

SVHC are addressed through the authorization system (REACH Title V11). The substances of Very High Concern are identified through the "candidate list" (referred to in Article 59 of the authorization system) and gradually they may be included (article 58) in Annex X1V (substances subject to authorization) of the REACH Regulations.

We hereby certify that below mentioned products do not contain more than 0,1% (w/w) of any substances of very high concern listed in the ECHA candidate list in accordance with article 33 of REACH Regulations.
