Per definition of REACH, all products manufactured, distributed or imported to the EU by STÄUBLI shall be considered as articles (REACH Article 3, point 3). Our STÄUBLI article do not contain any substances intended to be released during normal use. Accordingly, STÄUBLI has no obligation to make any pre-registrations and notification of substances (REACH Article 7).
