INTRODUCTION

FEATURES

1. HIGH RESOLUTION

1. This DVD Player used MPEG2 format to give high resolution pictures of over 500 "horizontal" lines.

2. UNIQUE FUNCTIONS

Multi-angle and multi-language bring unique functions. Parental lock makes it easy to control the content of discs.

3. SCREEN

4:3 and 16:9 "Wide screen" formats are available.

4. COMPATIBILITY

The appliance can play DVD,VCD,MP3, CD and JPEG Disc.

5. TIME SEARCH

It can search a specific part on a disc.

6. MULTI-FUNCTIONS

Fast forward, fast reverse, slow play, frame play, repeat play and program play.

7. RESUME PLAY

It can memorize the position where the disc has stopped and resume playback at that position.

8. ON SCREEN DISPLAY

Coloured OSD gives easy to understand indication of functions and status.

9 . VIDEO OUTPUT

Composite video and RGB output can be connected to a suitable TV.

10. AUDIO OUTPUT

Stereo analogue audio output, coaxial digital audio output can be connected with any amplifier to enjoy high quality sound.

DETAILS AND PRECAUTIONS ON THE USE OF BATTERIES:

- Discard a used battery in nature or garbage pollutes and prevents the recovery of recyclable materials. It is therefore important **to limit consumption of batteries** and follow these guidelines:
- focus on alkaline batteries (that last longer than the saline batteries) and when possible, rechargeable batteries
- deposit batteries and accumulators in specific containers arranged among traders. For example, metals will be valued and polluted the environment because they contain heavy metals hazardous to health and the environment primarily (cadmium and nickel)

- We recommend an adult to supervise children when they change the batteries so that these instructions are complied with or to make himself the replacement of batteries.

PRINCIPLES FOR USING

This manual mainly describes how to operate the DVD player using the buttons on the remote control.

The buttons on the front panel of the DVD player operate the unit and the buttons have the same or similar names to those on the remote control.

The marks shown in the right chart are used in the manual.

May appear on the TV screen during operation. This icon means the function explained in the owner's manual is not available on that specific DVD video disc.

PREPARATIONS BEFORE OPERATION

PRECAUTIONS FOR DISCS

PLACEMENT

- Put the unit where ventilation is good enough to prevent overheating. Never put the unit in direct sunlight or near heat sources.
- Put the unit horizontally, never put any heavy object on the unit.
- To protect the laser, do not put the unit where there is dust. If there is dust on the laser, use a cleaning disc to clean it.
- Refer to the operation instructions of the cleaning disc before use.

CONDENSATION

Water will appear on the pickup lens in the following cases:

- The unit is suddenly moved from a cold place to a warm place.
- The unit had been used in a humid place. In this case, the unit will not work. Unload the disc and leave the unit on for about one hour to evaporate the condensation.

CLEANING

 Use a soft cloth with a little neutral detergent to wipe the cabinet, panel and controls.
 Never use abrasive paper, polishing powder or solvent like alcohol.

HANDLING DISC

To keep the disc clean, do not touch the play sides of the disc.

Do not attach paper or tape to the disc.





Keep the disc away from direct sunlight or heat sources.

Store the disc in a disc case after use.

CLEANING DISC

Wipe the disc outwards from the center with clean cloth.




Do not use any type of solvent such as thinner, benzine, commercially available cleaners or anti-static spray.

REMOTE CONTROL

- 1. Open the battery cover.
- Insert two AAA batteries, make sure to match
 "+" and "-" of the batteries to marks inside
 the battery compartment.
- 3. Point the remote control at the remote sensor, operate in the range of 5 meters and 60° from the front of the remote sensor. Make sure there is no obstruction between them.
- ① Batteries can last about 6 months Change the batteries if the remote does not work.
- ② If the remote control is not used for a long time, remove the batteries to prevent battery leakage.







USB/CARD READER OPERATION

Insert your USB device or memory card, press USB/CARD button to select the USB device or memory card source, Press **Direction key** to move ,Press **ENTER** button to confirm your selection .When you chose the file from the USB device or memory card, the DVD player will play the media file automatically



Connect to a TV




A. RCA JACK

- Plug the yellow coloured RCA cable into the VIDEO OUT jack on the back of the DVD player, plug the opposite end of the cable in the Video input jack of your TV.
- 2) Plug the red and white coloured RCA cables into the AUDIO OUT jacks on the back of the DVD player. Plug the opposite end of the cable to the audio input jacks on the rear of your TV.

CONNECTIONS

Coaxial connection



- 1. Afer connecting radio antenna with FM ANT, then pressing "DVD/FM" on the remote control to transfer, in FM state, press "auto scan" on remote control to search radio. when radio begins, it succeed.
- 2.Plug a RCA cable into the COAXIAL DIGITAL OUT jack on the back of the DVD player. Connect the other end of the cable to the Digital Coaxial input on your amplifier.

FUNCTION SETTING

GENERAL MENU

Select GENERAL SETUP in the SETUP MENU and then select the desired option using the cursor (▲, ▼, ◄, ▶)buttons to navigate through the menus/ screens and press the ENTER button to select.



TV Display

- 4: 3/PS: Pan scan. Select when the unit is connected to a conventional TV. Video material formatted in the Pan Scan style is played back with the left and right edges are cut off.
- 4: 3/LB: Letter Box. Select when the unit is connected to a normal TV. Wide-screen images are shown on the screen with a black band at the top and bottom.
- **16:9** :Select when the unit is connected to a wide-screen TV.



Note:

The displayable picture size is preset on the DVD disc. Therefore the playback picture of some DVD discs may not conform to the picture size you select.

Angle Mark

Some DVDs include scenes recorded from different angles. This selection can show the marking.



On-Screen Display Language

You can set the SETUP and on-screen messages to appear in English, French, Italian or Spanish. This language selection will not affect the languages of DVD disc or Title menus or any audio or subtitle languages.



Captions

This option can show or hide the captions.

- ON (show captions)
- OFF (hide captions)

Note: This function can only be used for DVD disc with captions.



The TV set must support closed captions function.

Screen Saver

The Screen Saver is the moving DVD logo that appears on your TV screen when Disc playback is stopped and you do not use the player or its remote control for about few minutes. The screen saver prevents damage to your TV caused by leaving a still image on the screen for a long time.

AUDIO SETUP

Select audio setup in the setup up menu and then select the desired option using the cursor (▲, ▼, ◄, ▶) buttons to navigate through the menus/screens and press the enter button to select.



SPEAKER SETUP

Select speaker setup in the setup up menu and then select the desired option using the cursor (\blacktriangle , \blacktriangledown , \clubsuit) buttons to select the desired option and press the ENTER button to select.

Downmix

- LT/RT
- A disc recorded multi channel soundtrack, the output signal will be incorported to left and right channel.
- STEREO
- A disc recorded multi channel soundtrack, the output signal will be incorported to stereo.



SPDIF Output

- Press ▲ or ▼ to select SPDIF output, then press ENTER.
- Press ▲ or ▼ to select SPDIF OFF, SPDIF/ RAW, or SPDIF/PCM, then press ENTER.
- Choose SPDIF OFF if no external audio equipment is connected.
- Select SPDIF RAW if the player is connected to a 5.1 home theatre system by a coaxial cable (not supplied).
- Select SPDIF PCM to enable the internal Dolby Digital decoder of this player.



DOLBY DIGITAL SETUP

Select DOLBY DIGITAL SETUP in the setup up menu and then select the desired option using the cursor(♠,▼,◄,►) buttons to navigate through the menus/screens and press the enter button to select.

FUNCTION SETTING

Dual mono

This is the output mode of the L and Rsignals of the set audio output. If it is set to "MIX MONO", the function only works when the DVD being played is 5.0-channel.



STEREO

Choose this option, the audio output should be dummy stereo signal.

- L-MONO
- R-MONO
- MIX-MONO

Dynamic Range Compression

Dynamic Range Compression reduces volume changes by letting you adjust the difference between soft and loud sounds.

Press ▲ or ▼ to set Dynamic Range higher dynamic sound will be produced if dynamic range is selected.



VIDEO SETUP

Video

Select VIDEO SETUP in the set up menu, then press ENTER.

Video will be selected. Press ▶.

 Press ▼ or ▲ to select CVBS, RGB then press ENTER.



Sharpness

Press ▼ or ▲ to select High, Medium, Low then press ENTER.



Brightness

For BRIGHTNESS, the range is -20 to +20.



FUNCTION SETTING

Contrast

For CONTRAST, the range is -16 to +16.



PREFERENCE SETUP MENU

Select PREFERENCE SETUP in the setup menu, then press ENTER.

TV Type

TV type will be selected. Press ▶.

- Press ▲ or ▼ to select PAL, Auto or NTSC then press ENTER.
- Choose PAL if your TV is PAL -compatible.
 Choose Auto if your TV is Auto-compatible.
 Choose NTSC if your TV is NTSC -compatible.



Audio

Audio will be selected Press ▶

 Press ▲ or ▼ to select the desired audio language and then press ENTER.



Subtitle

Subtitle will be selected. Press ▶.

 Press ▲ or ▼ to select the desired subtitle language and then press ENTER.



Disc Menu

Disc menu will be selected. Press ▶.

Press \blacktriangle or \blacktriangledown to select the desired disc menu language and then press ENTER.



Parental control levels

Parental lock will be selected. Press ▶.

- Press ▲ or ▼ to select a parental control level (1–8),then press enter or select off to completely turn off the parental controls.
- Press the number buttons to enter your 4-digit password as requested, then press ENTER.

You cannot play DVD discs rated higher than the level you selected unless you cancel the parental lock function.

RATING EXPLANATIONS

- KID SAF Kid safe; it is safe even for kids.
- G General Audience; recommended as acceptable for viewers of all ages.
- PG Parental Guidance suggested.
- PG 13 Material is unsuitable for children under age 13.
- PG-R Parental Guidance-restricted; recommended that parents restrict children under age 17 from viewing or allow children to view only when supervised by a parent or adult guardian.
- R Restricted, under 17 requires accompanying parent or adult guardian.
- NC-17 NO children under age 17; not recommended viewing for children under age 17.
- ADULT Mature material; should be viewed only by adults due to graphic sexual material, violence, or language.

Notes: Parental control is a relatively new feature encoded into DVD discs. Currently very few DVD titles (if any) include parental control.

"PASSWORD": You need in "PASSWORD" setting to set the NEW PASSWORD or use SUPERUSER PASSWORD" "0000".



Parental control Password

Parental control limits viewing of DVDs when a DVD has movie rating that exceeds the parental level you selected.

To adjust the PARENTAL level so that DVDs cannot be played if the level has exceed, see PARENTAL CONTROL LEVELS. Press ▼ and ► to select password, CHANGE will be highlighted and then press ENTER.



- A box beside OLD password will be highlighted.
 Press the number buttons to enter your Old 4-digit password. The box beside NEW password will be highlighted automatically.
 - Press the number buttons to enter new 4-digit password of your choice. The box beside CONFIRM PWD will be highlighted automatically.
- Press the number buttons to enter the same new 4-digit password you just entered for the NEW PASSWORD.
- · Press ENTER to save the new password.



To clear 4-digit password if you forget your password, follow the procedure below.

- At the change page enter 4-digit number "0000" (SUPERUSER PASSWORD) and then press ENTER.
- 2. Enter a new password.

NOTES: When first time to use this DVD player, "OLD PASSWORD" just press ENTER to bypass. Enter the NEW PASSWORD for this DVD player.

Default

To restore the original settings of the player, follow the steps below.

Press ▼ and ► to select DEFAULT.
RESET will be highlighted. Press ENTER.

The original settings of the player will be restored.






TV/AUDIO SELECTION

Press POWER button on the TV and audio system.

1. Press "TV/VIDEO" on the TV, select VIDEO mode (TV).



 Select the correct audio input on the amplifier. Each amplifier is different from another, please refer to the manual of the amplifier. (E.g., Connect the audio output of the DVD player to the DVD audio input of an amplifier.)



Notes: This step can be cancelled if you do not connect it to the amplifier.

BASIC PLAY CDVD CD CD CD CD CD-RS

Preparation for playing a DVD.

- Switch on the TV and audio amplifier if used.
- 1.Press the POWER button of the DVD player. A display should now be seen on the TV screen. Most TV's will select the DVD input when the DVD player is turned on. Older TV's may need switching to AV input.

Play DVD's and VCD's

The TV screen shows the DVD title and menu. For VCD it will play automatically.

PLAY CD and MP3's

Put in the disc and the player will plays the disc automatically. Press ▲/▼ to select another track then press ENTER to play.

5. Stop playback. Push the "Stop" button twice to fully stop playback.




6. When you have finished using the player remove the disc with the ≜ button and close the tray. Turn off the player.

SELECT ANGLES

SELECT ANGLES (DVD)

Some discs have images with different screen angles, you may select among them. For example, when you watch a running train, you may watch it from the front, the left window or the right window without stopping it.



Example: A DVD has four screen angles (Subject to the movie) available.

1. Press ANGLE button to select ANGLE1.

The screen shows:




- Press ANGLE button again to select other angles, the screen shows respectively:
- 3. While a disc is playing, press ANGLE on the remote (the Angle Display appears).
- 4. Press ANGLE again, at the top right hand side there appears:

2/3 (select ANGLE 2)
3/3 (select ANGLE 3)

Select the angle you prefer then press SELECT on the remote control.

OSD



When you press the OSD button once, the screen shows:



When you press OSD button twice, the screen shows:



Press OSD button three times, the screen shows:



Press OSD button four times, the screen shows the audio language.



Press OSD button five times, the screen shows:



Press OSD button again the screen resumes to normal play mode.



SELECT SUBTITLE LANGUAGE


You can select the subtitle language from those indicated on discs. This operation works only with discs on which multiple subtitle languages are recorded.



1. Press SUBTITLE, the screen shows:



2. Keep pressing this button to select the desired language.



Remove the subtitle: Press SUBTITLE until the screen shows "SUBTITLE OFF".

Notes:

- For some discs, subtitles can not be removed.
- Different discs differ in the language of Subtitles.
- If the subtitles of discs can not be selected, Press SUBTITLE, the screen will show "NO SUBTITLE".

You may select a subtitle as required. Some discs may not have "SUBTITLE OFF" function.

You may program the chapter on a disc and play them in the programmed order.



1.Press ▲ or ▼ to select disc menu, pess prog the screen appears:





You may directly enter a time, title or chapter number to search fast on a disc, the player plays from that point.



PLAY DVD

- 1 Press TIME button to go to a chapter. For example, enter Chapter 2 in title 6.



OTHERS

TROUBLE SHOOTING

If you experience the following problems while using the player, this trouble shooting guide can help you.

No Sound

- Check if the unit is connected securely.
- Make sure you operate the TV or amplifier correctly.
- Make Sure you have selected DVD player position on the amplifier.
- Check the Audio or Digital output Setting.

No Image

- Check if the unit is connected securely.
- Make sure you operate the TV correctly.
- Check the TV type for correct system standard e.g. NTSC. PAL.

Bad Sound Quality

- Make sure the audio output mode is set correctly.
- Make sure the audio connection between the player and amplifier is correct.
- Increase the centre speaker level.
- Check DOWNMIX setting is OFF.

Disc can not be played

- There is no disc in the unit.
- Put the disc on the disc tray properly with the label side up.
- Moisture has condensed in the unit. Remove the disc and leave the unit on for about one hour (at power on condition).
- DVD may be wrong region.

Remote Control does not work

- Point the remote control at the remote control sensor of the player.
- Replace the batteries with new ones.
- Object blocking line of sight between remote control and player.

Player buttons & remote do not work

In very rare occasions the player may not respond when you press buttons on the remote or on the player's front panel. To remedy this problem simply turn off the power or unplug the player, wait one minute and resume normal operation.
