

to appliance of this range weighs more than 20 kg, so that one-person alone can move them. For the weight of each item, lease see Table 1.

rhile moving or installing the appliance, you shall wear gloves or similar protection means in order to prevent accidents for our own and third persons' safety.

istall your appliance according with III. 1.

asten your appliance steadily by means of wall mounting brackets or clamps if the installation is effected directly on the ipe (both fittings are supplied by us, see iii, 1 # ref. 2-5).

the appliance specific installation doesn't provide a proper canalization or other protections for the mouths access, it is bsolutely imperative that a protection wire-netting (supplied on request, see III. 2) is installed on the mouths, in order to revent the risk of access to the moving parts.

# rovide proper electric protections according to the installed model. S APPLIANCES ARE SHEET-MANUFACTURED, IT IS ABSOLUTELY IMPERATIVE THAT THEY ARE CONNECTED TO THE ROUND SYSTEM OR COLLECTOR ON THE INSTALLATION SPOT.

Then all the electric connection are carried out, check the connection terminals for their correct locking, close the outlet ox and start the appliance.

fter the appliance has started, check whether:

the rotation direction is correct, i.e. according to the indication on the contact box (III. 1 # 3)

the electric absorption corresponds to the rating

excessive vibrations can compromise the appliance stability.

hould the appliance be connected through a regulator, make sure that said regulator is proportionate to the power of the programme appliance.

#### MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

he motor and the Ian wheel shall be periodically controlled, according to the handled fluid and with the operation type; flerwards every six months of continuous operation.

he appliance maintenance shall be carried out just by qualified persons. efere any maintenance or cleaning operation, switch off the appliance by opening the master switch or the specific afely switch of the appliance.

uring the normal cleaning operations, check the integrity of all appliance parts.



- Do not place the device or relative parts in water or liquids, except where indicated in the cleaning and maintenance section.

- the appliance housing and the fan wheel shall not present damages owed to impact or deformation - the fan wheel shall 1) move completely free from any impediment, 2) be well fastened to its rotation shaft and rotate freely.
- Apply immediately to a qualified person for any doubt.

THIS MANUAL MUST ALWAYS BE READILY AVAILABLE.

- . Do not leave packing parts within the reach of children or unskilled people. Do not dump any hazardous parts into the environment (polystyrene, plastic, polypropylene, etc.).
- If the product is dropped or badly knocked, immediately contact qualified personnel (authorised dealer, service centre or manufacturer) to check that the product operates correctly.
