The printer YKE-01 is an ASCII-compatible label printer, which can be used with all KERN balances.

4. Set Up and commissioning

On the installation site observe the following:

Dust and humidity free

Do not place printer next to powerful sources of heat

Do not place the device within range of strong electric, magnetic, electromagnetic impulse fields and surfaces that collect electrostatic charge.

Do not expose printer to direct sunlight, impacts or vibration.

Power is supplied via the external mains adapter.

The stated voltage value must be the same as the local voltage.

Only use original KERN mains adapters.

Using other makes requires consent by KERN.

5. Printer parts

View from front side:

- 6 On/Off switch

6. Preparing your printer for operation

Connecting the cable:

Always use KERN accessories and weighing balances when working with your printer. Disconnect the printer from the mains voltage before connecting the cable to the printer.

7. Operating elements

After the connection of the mains adapter to the printer and to the power supply, as well as after the on/off switch of the printer having been switched over into "1" position, the green (right) display of the power supply will light up.

This indicator also signals that the printer is ready for operation.

LEDs:





LED green:

• Printer is ready for operation, Printer is correctly connected to power supply

LED red:

- Cover for paper compartment has been opened
- No paper roll in the printer
- Paper backlog

Buttons:

Ι	 Call up menu Change menu items in the menu Short pressing: Paper forward feed
Z	Exit menuAcknowledge menu items in the menu

8. The menu

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If no buttons are operated after approx. 7 seconds, the printer exits the menu automatically and you have to restart from the beginning.

Menu overview

To print out the menu overview, press shortly, after approx. 1 second press , the menu with the currently set data will be printed out.

Operation of the menu:

After the text in the menu overview

Press left button to change right button to validate. Press right button for a long time the configuration.

having been printed out,

- the individual menu items can be called up, set and confirmed. (must take place within approx. 7 sec., otherwise the printer exits from the menu)
- even if a menu item has not been changed, it must be confirmed by
- only after having confirmed all menu items, the complete menu with the newly set menu items will be printed out

Call up menu by immediately after the above mentioned text having been displayed

- Press i to change settings
- Press to acknowledge settings

9. Storage conditions and use of thermal paper

Long-term usability of thermal paper is achieved by correct storage.

Storage:

- 1 - Dark storage location (no direct sunlight)
 - Maximum relative air humidity 65%
 - Maximum temperature 25°C

Always store printed paper under the following conditions:

- Do not expose to direct sunlight or intensive room lights
- Avoid contact with alcohol, solvents or similar substances (e. g. adhesives),
- 1 - Do not store inside PVC pockets
 - Storage temperature $< 25^{\circ}$ C.

11.Instant help

Symptom	Remedy
The LED of the power supply display is not illuminated	Check whether the power supply unit is correctly connected to the printer and to the power supply.
Paper does not emerge.	Check whether the paper has been inserted correctly,
Paper leaves printer without print:	Check whether the paper has been inserted with its thermo-sensitive side facing the printer head,
No printing is taking place and paper does not emerge.	Check whether the adapter cable between printer and balance is correctly connected.
Wrong characters are printed	Check whether the parameters in the printer menu and the balance settings are set correctly.
Printout is blurred	Check whether the operating temperature does not exceed the allowed value, whether the paper recommended by the manufacturer is used.
