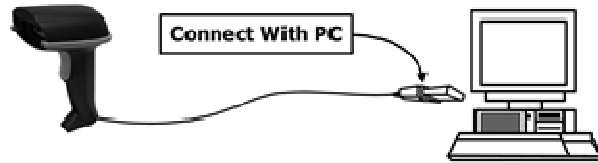

Make sure that the scanner has the correct cable to plug into PC as below described, After you plug cable into PC and hear the beep sound, the scanner can read the barcodes now.



### Reset Configuration to Default :

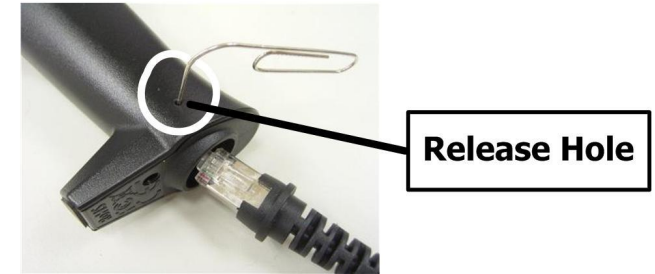
