- Store your CD or other devices in a cool area to avoid damage from heat.




WARNING:

POWER SOURCE

This unit is designed to be operated on AC/DC.

AC OPERATION

Plug the tail of AC power cord into AC socket on unit and the plug into household AC outlet. The batteries will be automatically disconnected.

DC OPERATION

Open the BATTERY COMPARTMENT DOOR. Install 6 pcs UM-2/C size batteries (not included) into compartment. Please follow correct polarities as indicated.

CAUTION

Remove batteries if they are flat or not being used for a long period of time.

Batteries contain chemical substances, so they should be disposed of properly.

BASIC FUNCTIONS

TURNING THE UNIT ON/OFF

Press the O/FUNC button to turn the unit on, press and hold the O/FUNC button to turn the unit off.

Note: In AUX/CD /TAPE mode, when the unit is not providing the main function for 15 minutes, the unit will automatically switch into standby mode. Press the 心/FUNC. button to turn on the unit again.

Please note that low volume setting in the audio source may be recognized as "no audio signal", this will affect the capability of signal detection from the device and can also originate an automatic switch into standby mode. If this happens please reactive the audio signal transmission or increase the volume setting on the audio source player in order to resume playback.



Electrostatic Discharge hints-The unit may reset or many not reset to normal operation mode due to electrostatic discharge, just switch if off and reconnect again.

ADJUSTING VOLUME

Press the volume+/ volume-button to increase or decrease volume.

HEADPHONE JACK

For private listening, connect a 3.5mm headphone (not included) to the HEADPHONE jack. The SPEAKER will be automatically disabled.

HEADPHONE WARNINGS:

Set the volume of the device to minimum before using headphones. A volume that is set too high can lead to hearing impairment / damage over a long period of time. Therefore, to protect your hearing, use a comfortable room volume.

USING THE CASSETTE

UNDERSTANDING THE BUTTONS

PLAY - Press to play cassettes.

REWIND - From stop mode, press to rewind the tape toward the beginning.

F.FWD - From stop mode, press to advance the tape toward the end.

STOP/EJ. - Press to stop current tape activity or to open the cassette compartment door when no buttons are active.

PAUSE - Press to interrupt tape play mode. Press the second time to resume tape play mode.

PLAYING A CASSETTE TAPE

- 1. Press the U/FUNC. button on unit to select TAPE mode.
- 2. Press STOP/EJ. Key to open the cassette compartment door.
- Insert cassette tape into the compartment with the open edge facing up and the full reel on the right.
- 4. Close the door securely.
- 5. Press REWIND or F.FWD to move tape to the desired starting point.
- 6. Press PLAY key to begin playing the tape.
- 7. Adjust the volume to your desired listening level.

AUTOMATIC STOP FEATURE

When the cassette deck is operating in play mode and the end of the tape is reached, the unit automatically shuts itself off and returns all buttons to the off position.

RADIO OPERATION

- 1. Press the U/FUNC. button on unit to select the FM function.
- Tune to desired station by pressing the TUN.+/ → or TUN.-/ → button on unit, the display will show the band frequency. Example: FM 97.10 MHz. If the radio receive Stereo signal, "ST" will show on the display.
- Press and hold the TUN.+/ I or TUN.-/ I BUTTON, the unit will scan the frequencies until a broadcasting station strong enough for good reception is found.
- 4. Extend FM TELESCOPIC ANTENNA to its full length and gently move the unit back and forth to get the best reception, or place the unit in an open location.
- To turn off the radio, press the ⁽¹⁾/_UFUNC. button to select other functions, or press and hold the ⁽¹⁾/_UFUNC. button to turn off the unit.

RADIO AUTO SCAN (SEARCH)

Press the ►I /SCAN button on unit, the unit will conduct auto scan and program until having found a strong signal. The unit will start to broadcast from the P01 after searching finished. Use the **M.+** or **M.-** button to choose between the preset stations.

RADIO STATION MEMORY OPERATION

You may pre-store 30 (FM) radio stations in memory for your preference.

- 1. Press the TUN.+/ → or TUN.-/ i button to select the first desired station. Then press and hold the **PROG./M./P-MODE** button on unit, "P01" will show on the display.
- 2. Use M.+ or M.- button to choose the desired sequence you want to store, then press the PROG./M./P-MODE button on unit to confirm.
- 3. Search another station, repeat steps (1) & (2) until all desired stations stored. Up to 30 stations can be programmed.
- 4. To choose between the stored stations, press the M.+ or M.- button.

CD OPERATION

Discs for Playback

This system only can playback digital audio CD, finalized digital audio CD-Recordable (CD-R) discs, finalized digital audio CD-Rewritable (CD-RW) discs.

LOADING A DISC

- 1. Press the 0/FUNC. button on until to select "CD" mode.
- 2. Press the OPEN/CLOSE button to open the CD door, "OP" will be shown on the display.
- 3. Place an audio CD DISC into the tray with the front side facing up.
- 4. Close the CD door.

The display will show a flashing "- - -", then the total number of tracks and the playback will starts from the first track.

 To remove the CD, press STOP button and press OPEN/CLOSE button to open CD door, the display will show "OP". Hold the CD by its edges, and carefully take it out.



Note:

- A Make sure the disc is stopped before opening the CD DOOR.
- To ensure good system performance; wait until the unit completely reads the disc before proceeding.
- ♦ If no disc loaded into the tray, or the disc is unreadable, the display will show "NO".

PLAYING A DISC

 The unit will start playback from track 1 after reading finished. The track no. and play time would be shown on the display.

To interrupt playback, press the DI button. The play time will flash on the display.

To resume playback, press the **>** button again.

2. To stop playback, press the STOP button, the total number of tracks appears on the display.

SELECTING A DESIRED TRACK/PASSAGE

To select a desired track

Press the TUN.+/ I or TUN.-/ I button in stop mode or during play until the desired track appears on the display. It will start play automatically. If the unit is in stop mode, press I to start play.

To search for a particular passage during playback (track scanning at high speed)

Press and hold the TUN.+/ H or TUN.-/ H button to scan the current playing track at high speed until desired point passage, and then release the button. Playback will start again from this point.

PROGRAM TRACKS

Programming tracks of disc are possible when playback is stopped. Up to CD 20 tracks can be stored in the memory in any order.

- In stop mode, press the **PROG./M./P-MODE** button, the P01 will be on and "PROG" will flash on the display.
- Press the TUN.+/>> or TUN.-/<> button to select the first desired track to be programmed. Press the PROG/M./P-MODE button to enter. The display changes to show P02.
- 3. Repeat steps 1 & 2 to store other desired tracks until all tracks are programmed.
- 4. Press the ►I button to start playback from the first programmed track.
- Press the STOP button to stop program playback. To clear the program, you may press the STOP button when the disc stopped and open the CD compartment lid, program will be erased.

REPEAT PLAY

To Repeat a Single Track

- Press the PROG./M./P-MODE button once in play mode, "C >" will flash on the display. The current track will be played over and over again until you press the STOP button.
- To cancel repeat play, Press the PROG/M./P-MODE button until the "C >" disappears from the display.

To repeat all the Tracks

- 1. Press **PROG/M./P-MODE** button twice in play mode, "C→" shows steady on the display, all tracks on the disc will be played repeatedly until the STOP button is pressed.
- 2. To cancel repeat play, Press the **PROG./M./P-MODE** button until the "⊂, →" disappear.

RANDOM PLAY

Press the **PROG./M./P-MODE** button in play mode till the "**RDM**" shows steady on the display, the random play will start from next track automatically(or press CD skip forward button), until all tracks are played over and then it will stop. Press the **PROG./M./P-MODE** button again until the "**RDM**" disappears from the display to cancel.

INTRO

Press the **PROG./M./P-MODE** button on unit in play mode till the "**INTRO**" shows steadily on the display, the intro play will start and scan 10 seconds for every track. To cancel intro play, press the **PROG./M./P-MODE** button until "**INTRO**" disappears from the display.

AUX-IN OPERATION

This unit has provided special AUX-IN jack, through this jack other audio sources can be connected to this unit and be amplified.

- 1. Press the ^(U) /FUNC. button to select "AUX" mode.
- Connect the audio cable into the AUX-IN jack and the other end connect to the AUDIO OUT jack of the external audio source.
- 3. Adjust the volume of the main unit to your desired level.

Note: In Aux-in mode, Proceed play/ pause and next/ previous are controlled by the connected external device

COMPACT DISC MAINTENANCE

1. Always use a compact disc bearing the mark as shown.



- 2. Notes on handling discs
 - Removing the disc from its storage case and loading it.
 - Do not touch the reflective recorded surface.
 - Do not stick paper or write anything on the surface.
 - Do not bend the disc.
- 3. Storage
 - Store the disc in its case.
 - DO not expose discs to direct sunlight or high temperatures, high humidity or dusty places.
- 4. Cleaning a disc
 - Should the disc become soiled, wipe off dust, dirt and fingerprints with a soft cloth.
 - The disc should be cleaned from the center to the edge.



FROM THE CENTRE TO THE EDGE

- Never use benzene, thinners, record cleaner fluid or anti-static spray.
- Be sure to close the CD door, so the lens is not contaminated by dust.
- Do not touch the lens.
