





LET'S **GET STARTED**

HOW IT ALL WORKS

The 3Doodler Create+ extrudes heated plastic that cools almost instantly, allowing you to create solid, threedimensional objects.

START/STOP

Click either FAST/SLOW button:

- Once to START
- Once to STOP

REVERSING AND REMOVING PLASTIC

Double Click either button to **REVERSE**

Do not pull Plastic from the Pen until the Plastic has stopped moving.



Note: If your Plastic is too short to fully reverse, you will need to run it all the way through the Pen or use the tools to remove the Plastic left in the Pen. Please refer to the User Manual.

PICK YOUR PLASTIC

For optimal Doodling use these temperature settings for your Plastic:











Setting: PLA Light: Green How to tell: Very rigid when bent, no white semi-circles



CHANGING PLASTIC



When switching from a HI temp Plastic (ABS or FLEXY) to a LO temp Plastic (PLA), run Pen on ABS/FLEXY setting until HI temp Plastic is fully extruded (you'll see the Plastic color change!). Then switch Pen to the PLA temp setting.

SNIP THOSE ENDS!


Keep it clean. Snip your ends to avoid any unnecessary jams in your 3Doodler.





HOW TO DOODLE ON A FLAT SURFACE

- Click FAST button once. When Plastic starts extruding, push Nozzle down into paper to get Plastic to stick to surface.
- 2. Try writing your name. While Plastic is extruding, push Nozzle down. Drag Plastic along the paper or surface in a continuous unbroken line, as if you were writing with a pencil.
- Keep your movement slow and steady. Plastic should hold to the surface and not curl up around the Nozzle.
- 4. When you reach the end of your name, stop extruding by clicking the FAST button once again. Wait a moment before removing pen then simply peel off your doodle!



Extrude a Plastic blob onto a piece of paper.

- Lift Pen and Plastic up off the paper in a straight line.
- Click FAST button once to stop extruding, BUT DO NOT MOVE PEN YET.
- Wait a few seconds with the Pen still connected to the top of your Plastic line.
- Quickly pull Pen away. The line will remain vertical.

HOW TO CREATE A PYRAMID

DOODLING FLAT

 Click FAST button once. When Plastic starts extruding, push Nozzle down into paper to get Plastic to stick to surface. Draw a simple triangle.



2. Start at one corner. Click FAST button once and lift pen and Plastic up off the paper in a straight line. Click once to stop and wait a few seconds before moving pen away.

WELDING PLASTIC

3. You join the edges by touching the Nozzle of the 3Doodler to both parts to melt them together while extruding.

Don't worry about rough edges; you can trim those later.



IN A JAM? UNBLOCKING YOUR PEN





LED LIGHT RED FOR MORE THAN 2 MIN?

Exit idle mode by unplugging your pen and plugging it back in or by turning your pen off and on again.


3. USE UNBLOCKING TOOL

strand while applying pressure.

Remove the nozzle while the light is blue or green. Then force through plastic from the back or the front with the unblocking tool.

After you have finished using your 3Doodler, reverse or remove any remaining Plastic. Snip the ends now for smoother Doodling later!




Simply cover the bowl with masking tape and then Doodle to attach the cherries onto the tape.
