1.3 Points for attention on product use



Warning: in order to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock and personal injury, pay special attention to the following items:

- The product is 220-240V 50 / 60Hz. Pay attention to match the label on the machine's name plate. Do not use power supply inconsistent with rated voltage and frequency;
- If it is found that the power cord or plug is damaged, the power socket is loose, and the power plug and socket do not match, do not use this product, or it may cause electric shock or overheating and cause fire;
- This product should not be used by children or people with physical or mental disorders or lack of relevant experience and knowledge, unless someone responsible for their safety supervises or instructs them to use this product ;
- Do not pull the power cord at sharp edges and corners to prevent accidental damage to the power cord;
- Before using this product, please carefully check whether the power cord is damaged or aged. If the power cord is damaged, please do not continue to use this product to avoid the risk of electric shock;
- If the plug or power cord is damaged, in order to avoid danger, do not repair it by yourself, and it must be replaced by professional personnel designated by the manufacture.

- If the dryer fails to work properly, or the product is accidentally dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, please send it to a professional repair shop for inspection before the next use, and then use it normally after confirming the safety of the product;
- When the product is not in use, please turn off the product switch and unplug the power plug;
- Before cleaning and maintaining this product, please turn off the product switch and unplug the power plug;
- If the power cord is damaged or entangled, please turn off the product switch and unplug the power plug;
- DO not pull the power cord or the whole machine to pull out the power plug. Hold the plug and pull out the plug;
- The power line should be away from heat source, oil or sharp edge;
- It is recommended that this product be used in the circuit with leakage current less than 30mA;
- This product is only for indoor use and should not be exposed to rain, but should be stored indoor;
- It is not allowed to use in the pool, low-lying water and other similar places, and the product shall not be immersed in any liquid;

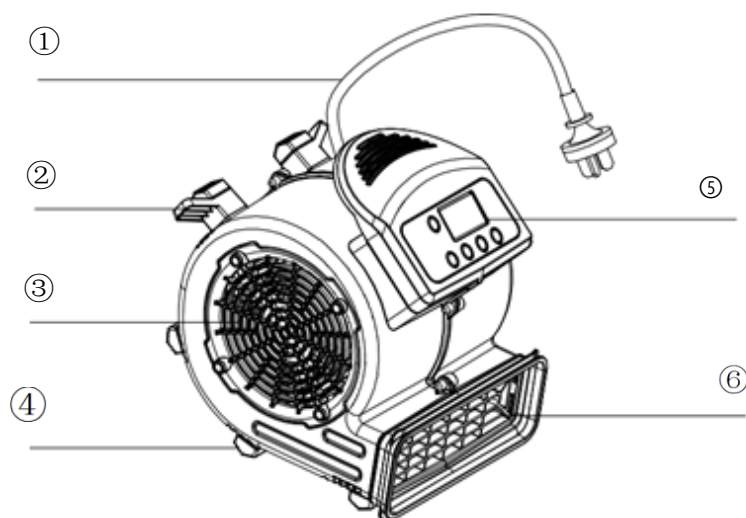

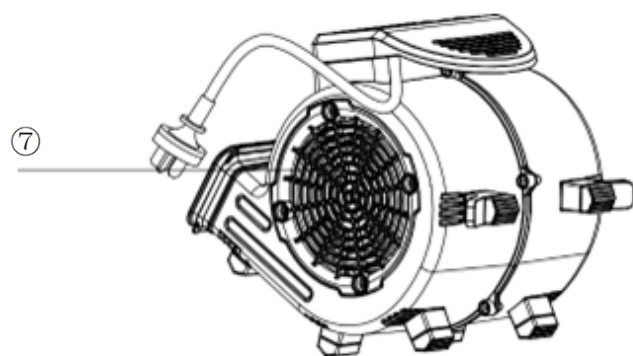
2. Grounding requirements

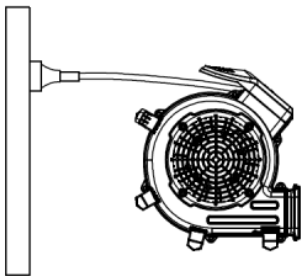

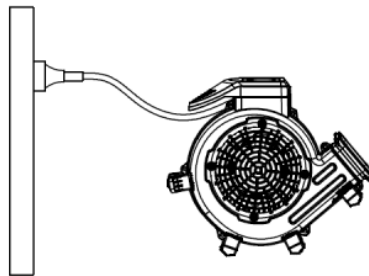

5. Product operating instructions

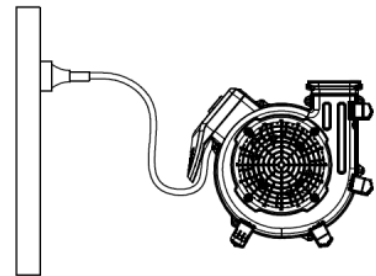
1. Check whether the display screen is in good condition before and after use to ensure that the power supply is cut off.
2. The air dryer should be placed in a dry and ventilated place or a stable plane. Make sure there is one foot distance between adjacent machines. Avoid placing in the place where there are cloths, paper and other inhalable dryers that cause air inlet blockage.
3. When the air dryer works in the designated target area, it should be placed in the working position correctly.
4. The air dryer must be powered on a grounded socket. For details, please refer to grounding instruction requirements or page 3. Do not extend the power cord by yourself.
5. After using, press the power button to turn off the machine. The display screen is black and the motor stops running. See page 9 for storage instructions.



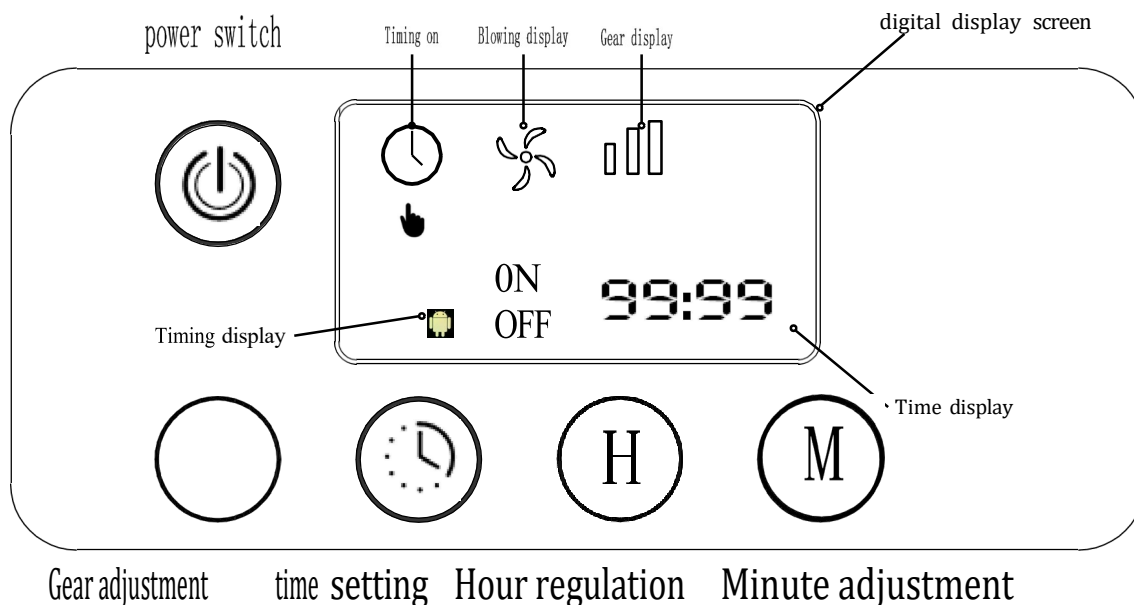

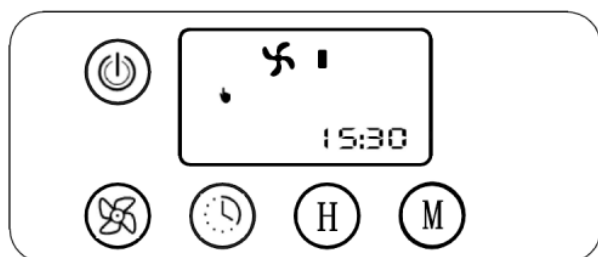

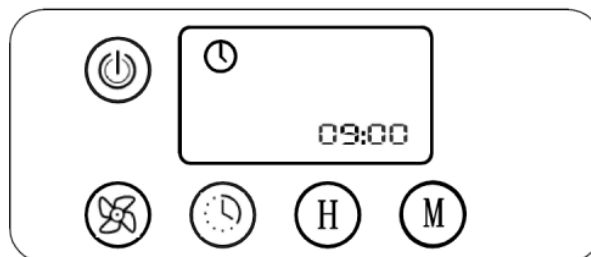
1. keys and functions

Five touch buttons: power switch, gear adjustment, time setting, hour adjustment and minute adjustment;

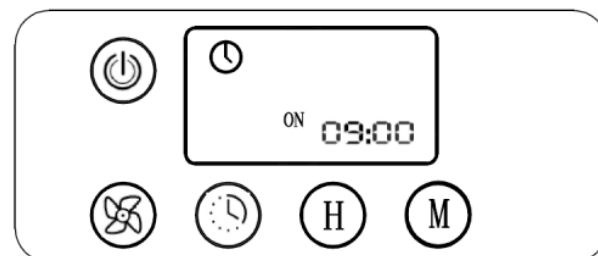
Three function settings: gear adjustment, timing setting, timing / manual mode;



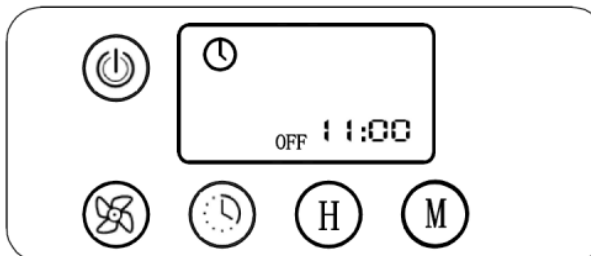
Press "power switch" to turn on the power and the screen will display time



Press "time setting" to enter the timing interface
Press "H", "M" to set hours / minutes



Press "opening time setting" to enter the opening time setting
Press "H", "M" to open at 9:00 through



Press "closing time setting" to enter the closing time setting
Press "H", "M" to close at 11:00 by setting

PS: when setting the timing, the interval time of each press should not exceed 3 seconds, otherwise, it will automatically return to the initial interface.

2. Interface switching

- 2.1 press the "power switch", the LCD will light up and enter the initial interface (Fig.1); Then press the "power switch" to turn off the LCD;
- 2.2 in the initial interface, gently press "gear adjustment" to start the motor manually; then gently press "gear adjustment" to switch the motor gear; press "gear adjustment" for a long time to turn off the motor manually;

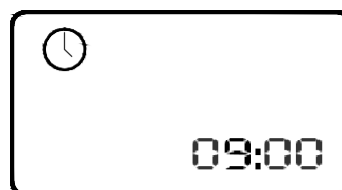


Figure 2 clock calibration interface

- 2.3 in the initial interface, lightly press "time setting" to enter the clock calibration of interface (Fig. 2). The system clock can be calibrated by pressing the "hour adjustment" and "minute adjustment" buttons ; press the "gear adjustment" or button for 3 seconds to return to the initial interface automatically;
- 2.4 in the clock calibration interface, lightly press "time setting" to enter the timing of time setting interface (Fig. 3), and the timing of time can be set through the "hour adjustment" and "minute adjustment" buttons (00:00 is the invalid time setting); lightly press "gear adjustment" or press the button for 3 seconds to automatically return to the initial interface ;
- 2.5 in the timing opening time setting interface, press "time setting" lightly to enter the timing closing time setting interface (Fig. 4) . The timing closing time can be set through the "hour adjustment" and "minute adjustment" buttons (00:00 is the invalid time setting); lightly press "gear adjustment" or press the button for 3 seconds to automatically return to the initial interface ;
- 2.6 in the initial interface, if "on" is displayed, it means that the setting of timing of time is effective; if "off" is displayed, it means that the setting of timing off time is effective ;
- 2.7 In the initial interface, if the robot pattern is displayed, it means that the timing function is enabled; if the palm pattern is displayed, it means that the timing function is not enabled;
- 2.8 in the initial interface, lightly press "hour adjustment" to view the time set for timing on; lightly press "gear adjustment" or press the button for 3 seconds to return to the initial interface automatically;
- 2.9 in the initial interface, lightly press "minute adjustment" to view the timing off setting time; lightly press "gear adjustment" or press the button for 3 seconds to automatically return to the initial interface;

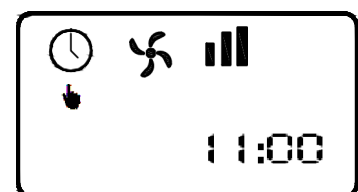


Figure 5 initial interface (timing function off)

- 2.10 in the initial interface, pressing "time setting" for a long time will automatically clear the timing on time and timing off time, and automatically return to the initial interface (Fig. 5).



Figure 1 initial interface (timing function on)

3. Motor startup and shutdown

- 3.1 when the timing function is off, press "gear adjustment" to start the motor and gear adjustment;
- 3.2 when the timing function is off, turn off the motor by pressing "gear adjustment" for a long time ;
- 3.3 when the timing opening function is effective, when the system time is equal to the set timing opening time, the motor will start automatically;
- 3.4 When the timed shutdown function is effective, if the system time is equal to the set shutdown time, the motor automatically shuts down;
- 3.5 when the timing function is effective, the user can also manually turn on and off the motor through the "gear adjustment" button;

4. Motor status display

- 4.1 on the initial interface, the current motor gear setting (high / medium / low) is displayed in real time.
- 4.2 in the initial interface, the upper left wind blade pattern displays the motor status in real time. The rotation of the wind blade indicates that the motor is running, and that the fan blade does not rotate indicates that the motor stops ;


5. Power-off preservation function

- 5.1 when the system is powered down, the motor gear, system clock and timing parameters will be automatically saved;
- 5.2 when the system is powered or again, the last set motor gear, system clock and timing parameters will be automatically called.

6. Precautions for clock parameters

- 6.1 "00:00" is invalid timing parameter ;
- 6.2 if the opening time and closing time are set at the same time, the timing setting is invalid;
- 6.3 when users use the system for the first time, it is recommended to calibrate the system clock through the above 2.3 ;

6 Storage

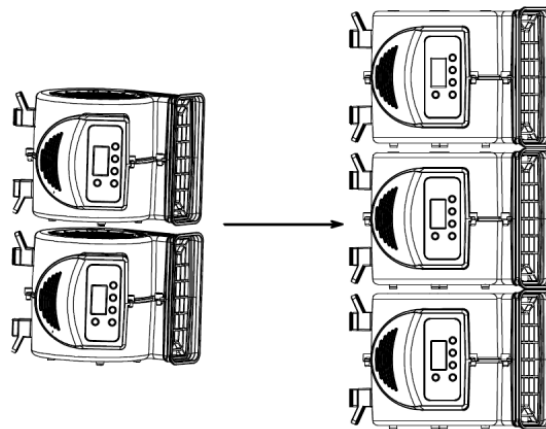
 Warning: do not place the dryer outdoors. Please store the machine in a ventilated and dry place, away from dangerous goods, such as toxic substances, carcinogens, inflammables, explosives, etc.

 Note: in order to avoid damage to the dryer, do not stack the dryer on more than three, please store the machine on a stable level.

6.1 power cord storage


Before storing the dryer, make sure that the power switch is off and cut off the power. Wind the power cord around the winder.

6.2 air dryer storage



To save space, the dryer can be stacked and stored, as shown in the figure above. When stacking, make sure that the convex part of the left side of the air outlet grille plate for stacking is correctly embedded into the corresponding stacking groove on the right side of the other dryer for fixing.

7 Maintenance

 Warning: after each overhaul or cleaning, make sure that the inlet grid plate, outlet grid plate and fan blade of the whole machine are installed in good condition.

Before and after each use of the product, please carefully check the plug and power cord for damage. If the plug or power cord is damaged, please stop using the product and send it to a professional service center for replacement of corresponding parts. Check that there is no foreign matter blocking and blocking around the inlet and outlet grid plates of the product.

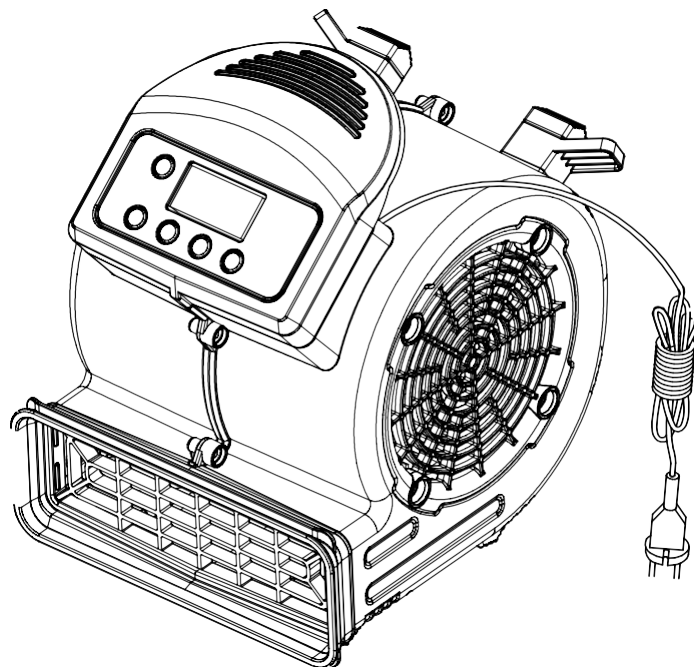
