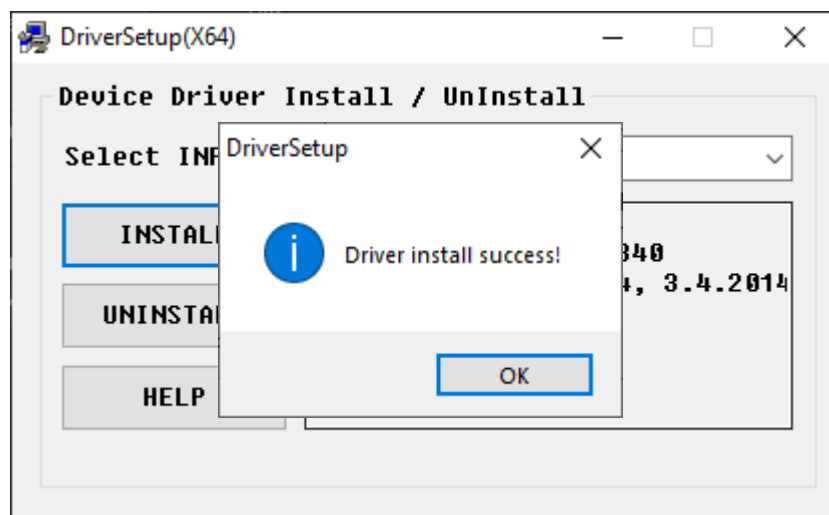
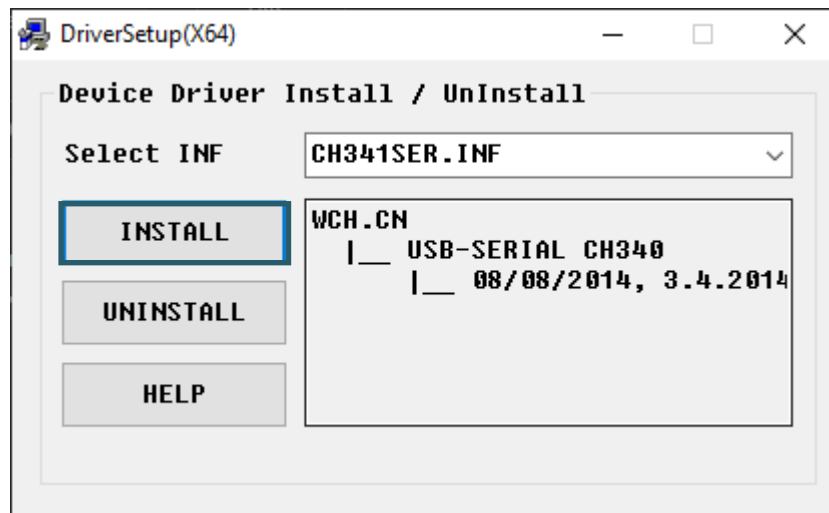
Note that this software is only compatible with the Windows operating system.

2. SOFTWARE INSTALLATION

You can download the latest version of the PC software from [our website](#).

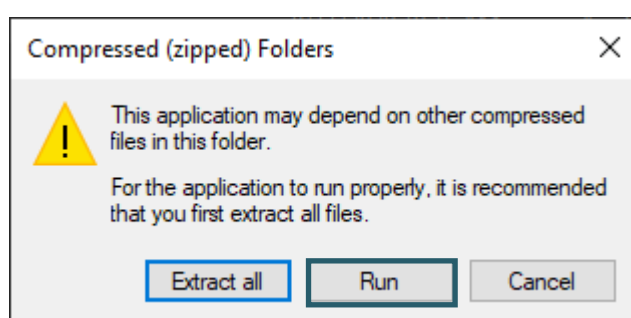
You do not need to unzip the .zip file. That means, you can immediately run the **SETUP.EXE** saved in **PSG9080_EN_Setup.zip** → **PSG_EN_Setup** → **Ch340 drive**.

Now, click on **INSTALL**.

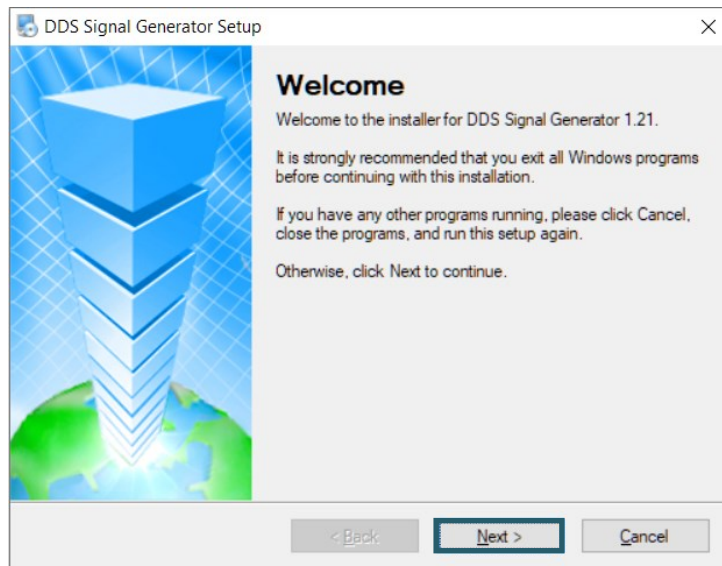


You will get the above message when the driver is successfully installed. After that, you can close the window. Afterwards, execute the **setupE.exe**, which is stored in **PSG9080_EN_Setup.zip** → **PSG_EN_Setup** → **English** → **PSG Application**.

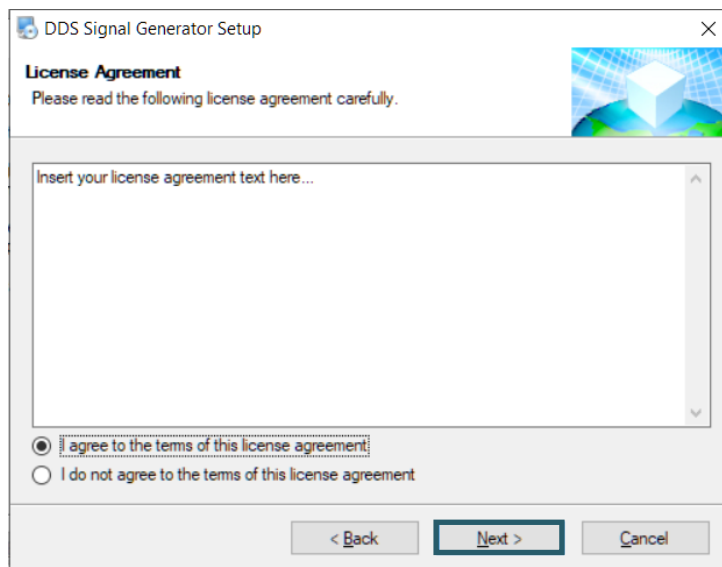
You may see the following warning message. In this case, click on **Run**.



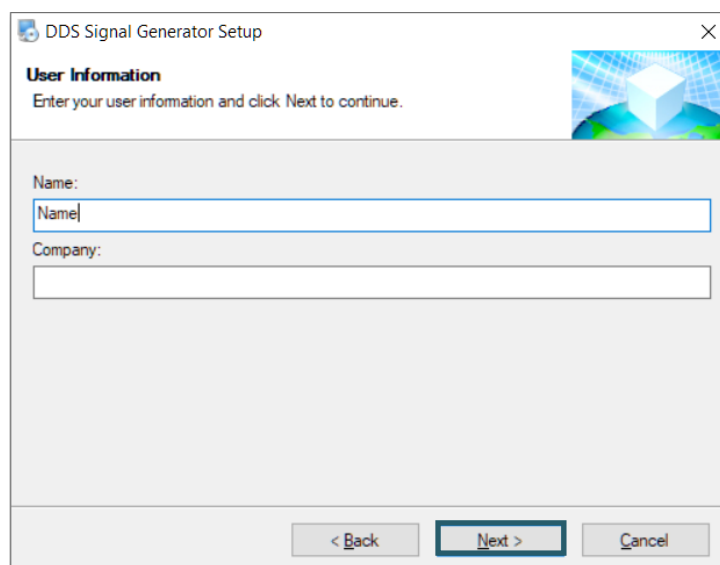
Click now on **Next >**.



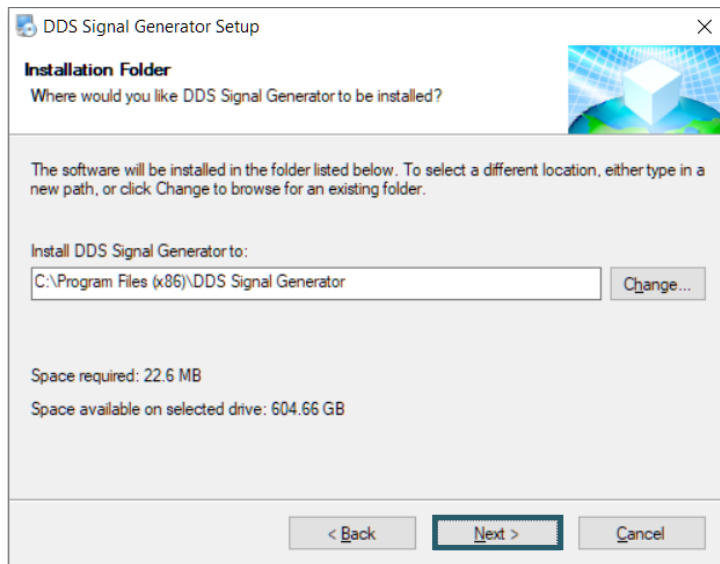
In the following step, agree to the license agreements and click on **Next >**.



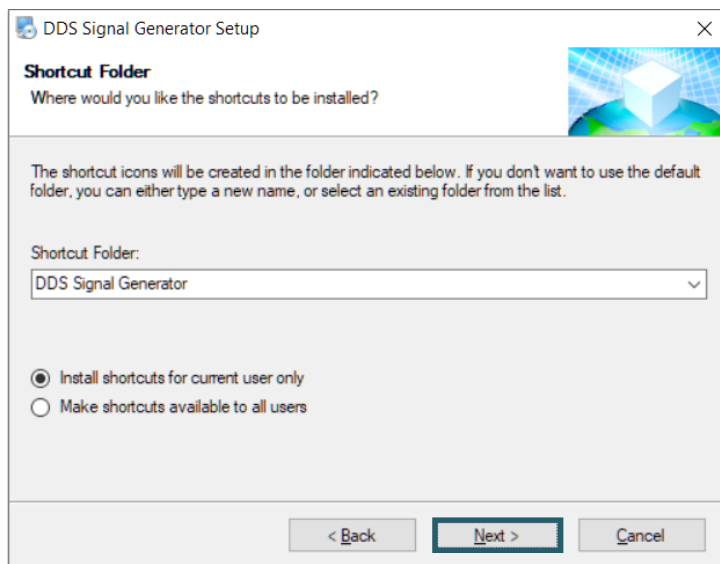
Click the **Next >** button in the following windows.



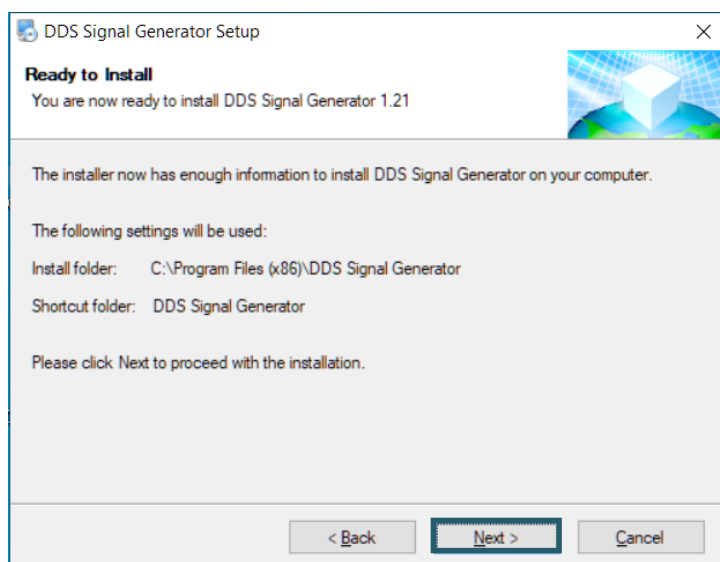
Select your installation folder and click **Next >**.



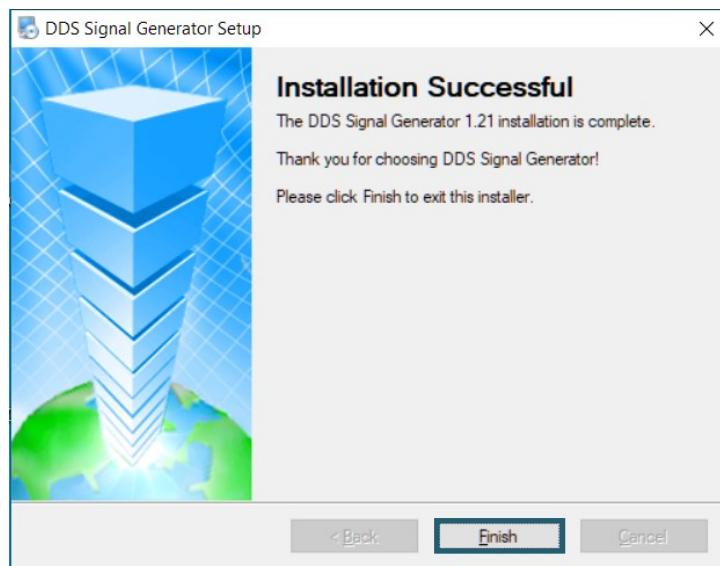
Select your shortcut folder and click **Next >**.



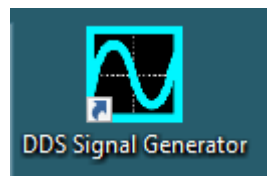
To start the installation, click **Next >**.



Finally, click on **Finish**.

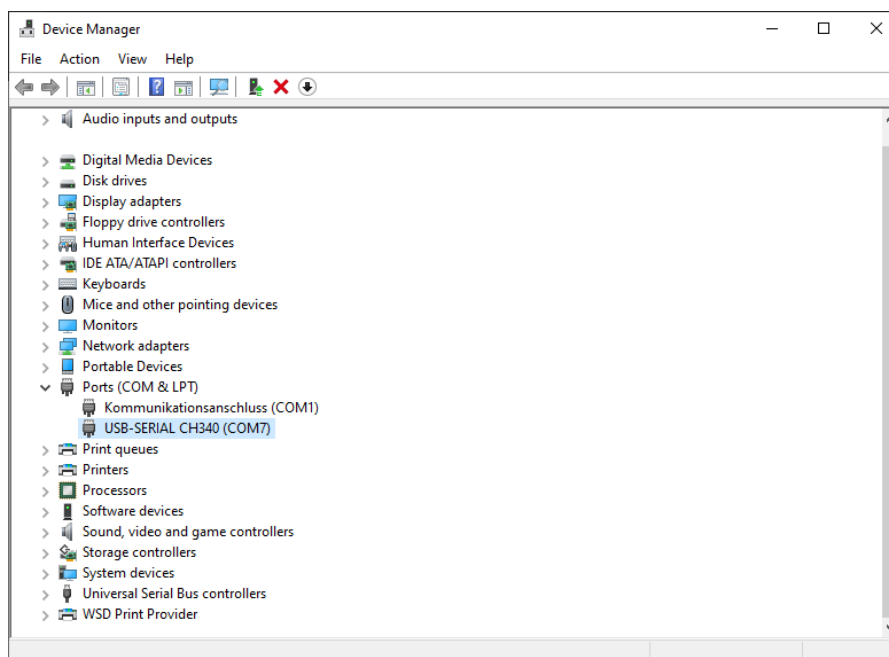


You have now successfully installed the software on your PC and a desktop shortcut has been created automatically.

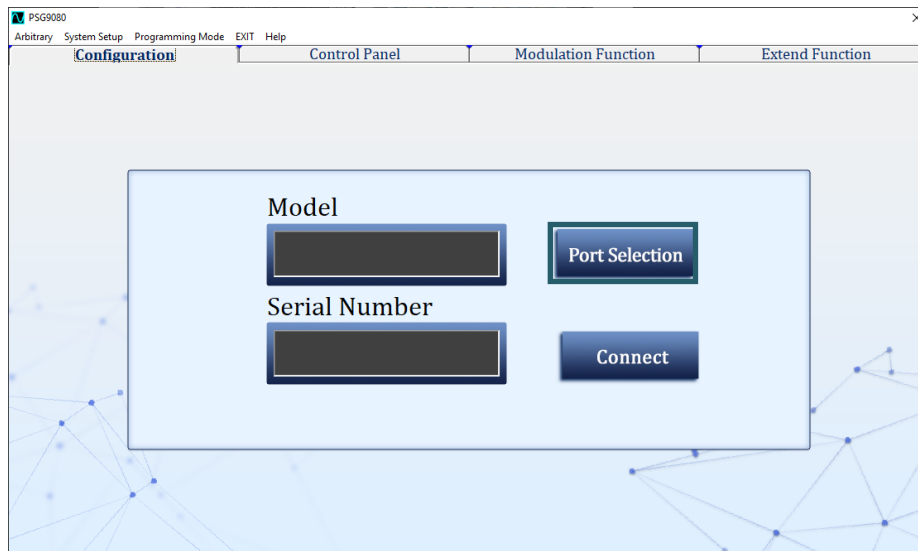


3. USE OF THE SOFTWARE

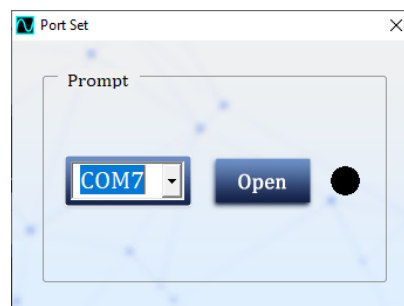
You can connect the switched-on signal generator to your PC using the USB cable, which is included in the delivery. The device should now be visible in the Device Manager.



When you now start the software, the configuration opens automatically. Click there on **Port Selection**.



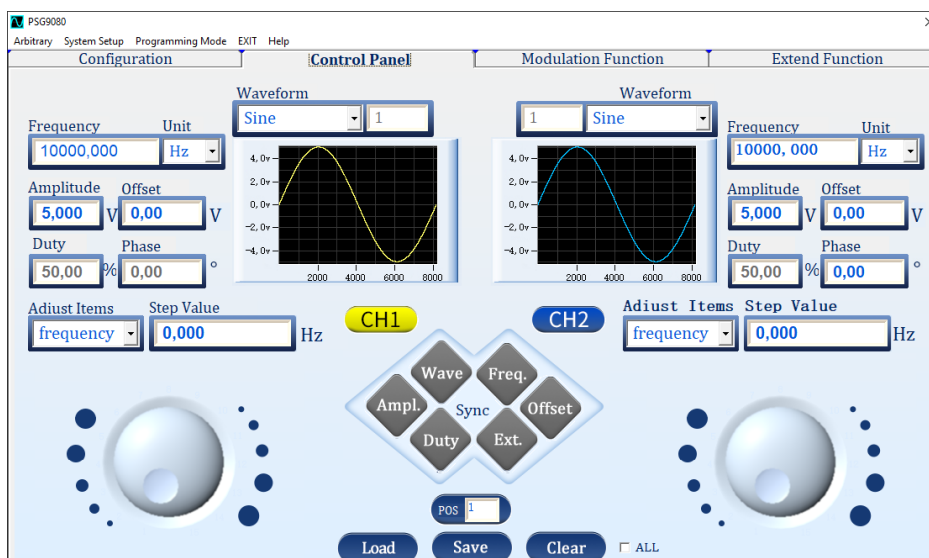
Now select the COM port to which the signal generator is connected. You can see the correct port in the Device Manager.



Now click on **Open** and afterwards on **Connect**. The model and the serial number of your device will now be displayed, if the device has connected successfully.

Control Panel

In this window, you can adjust the basic settings, such as waveform, frequency, amplitude and much more for the two output channels. You can also synchronize (Sync) the two channels in this window and also load pre-saved waveforms.



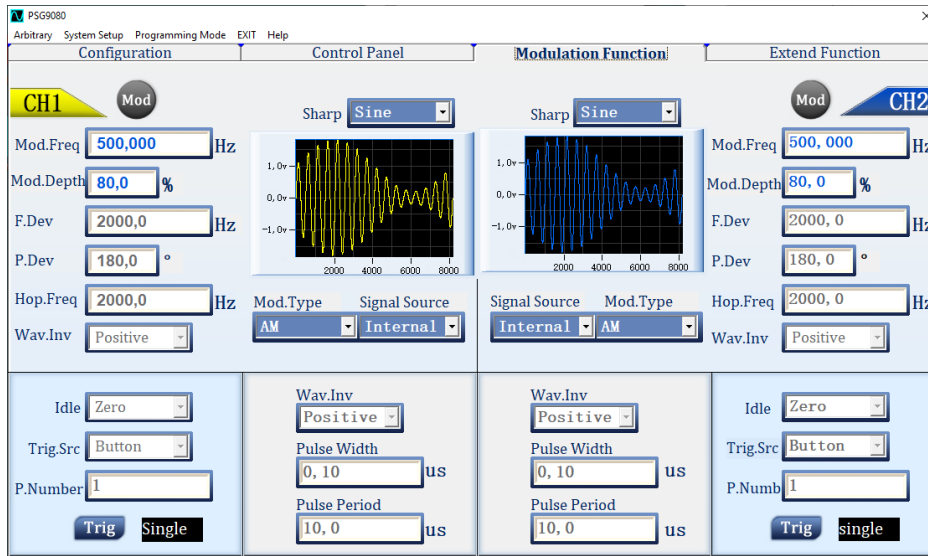
Modulation Function

This window contains the modulation function. Here you can modulate the signal in the same way as on the signal generator itself. The settings, which are located in the lower corners, refer to the modulation type Burst.

The P.Number describes the number of pulses.

The settings next to it belong to the modulation type Pulse.

All other setting items refer to all modulation types. The **Mod**-Buttons put the corresponding channel of the signal generator into modulation mode.

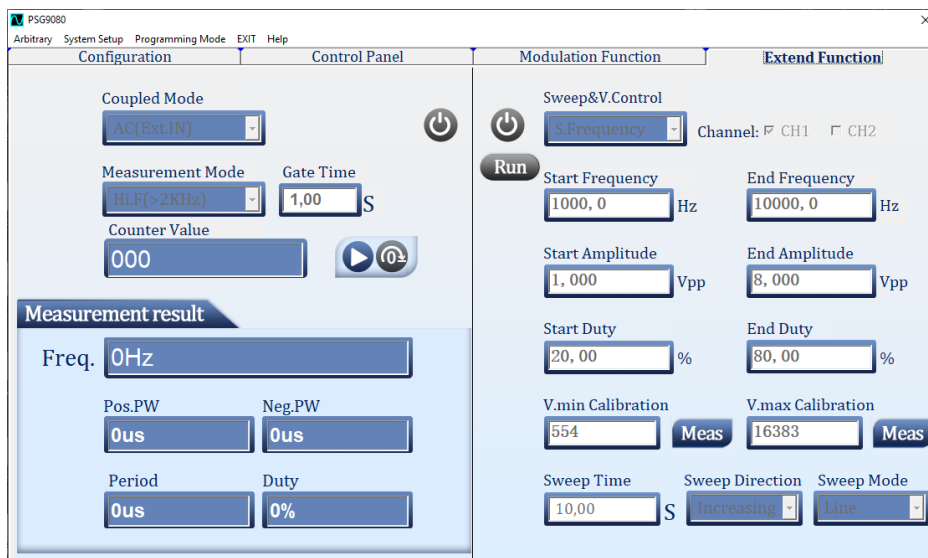


Extend Function

This window contains the functions voltage control mode, sweep mode and measuring mode.

The measuring mode is located on the left side of the window and can be activated or deactivated with the on/off switch.

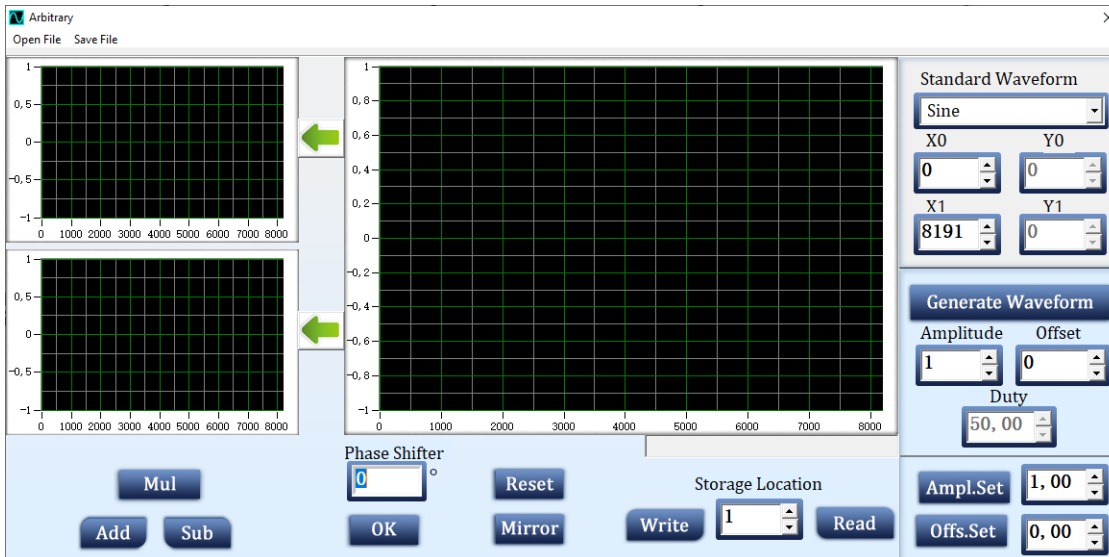
The voltage control mode and the sweep mode share the right side. There you can select the respective function and the to be set parameters.



Arbitrary

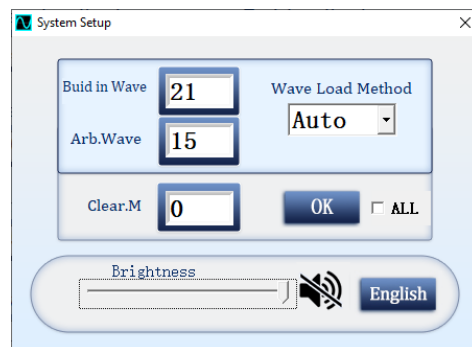
You can open this function in the menu bar under Arbitrary. Here you can generate custom waves.

You can load a basic waveform and edit it with the mouse. You can also transfer this waveform to the smaller time-voltage diagrams with the green arrows. If there is a graph in both diagrams, you can multiply, add or subtract these two graphs from each other.



Basic Setup

This function can be found in the menu bar under **System Setup**. There you can change the device settings



Sync Setup

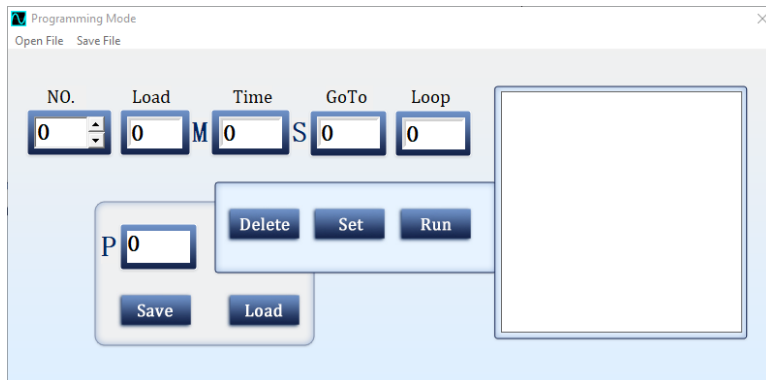
This function can also be found in the menu bar under **System Setup**. Here you will find the synchronization settings for the two channels, which can also be found in the *Control Panel*.



Programming Mode

You will find this function again in the menu bar.

In this window, you can program your signal generator. Here, you can automate a sequence of different signal outputs.



The menu bar also contains the EXIT and Help options.

With EXIT you close the software and with Help, you can view your software version.

Symbol on Electrical and Electronic Products:

This crossed-out bin means that electrical and electronic products do not belong into the household waste. You must hand over your old appliance to a registration place.
