2 Intended use

The product is a waterproof cable connector.

The product has an IP68 ingress protection rating. It provides total protection against small particles (e.g. dust, dirt). The product is water resistant up to 10 m depth for 1 hour.

The product is suitable for outdoor use.

The product has an IP68 ingress protection rating and is protected from dust and strong jets of water from any direction. The product is suitable for outdoor use. Do not submerge the product in water.

If you use the product for purposes other than those described, the product may be damaged.

Improper use can result in short circuits, fires, electric shocks or other hazards.

The product complies with the statutory national and European requirements.

For safety and approval purposes, you must not rebuild and/or modify the product.

Read the operating instructions carefully and store them in a safe place. Make this product available to third parties only together with the operating instructions.

4 Description of symbols

5.1 General

5.2 Handling

5.3 Operating environment

- Do not place the product under any mechanical stress.
- Protect the appliance from extreme temperatures, strong jolts, flammable gases, steam and solvents.

5.4 Operation

5.6 Electrical installation

WARNING! Safety hazard!

The product should only be installed by people with relevant electrical knowledge and experience! *)

*) Technical knowledge required to perform the installation:

For the installation, the following specialist knowledge is required in particular:

- The "Five safety rules": Disconnect from the mains; protect against accidental switch-on; ensure there is no voltage; earth and short-circuit; cover or protect adjacent live parts
- Use of suitable tools, measuring devices and personal protective equipment, where necessary
- Analysis of measurement results
- Use of electrical installation materials to meet the requirements for disconnection
- IP protection ratings
- Installation of electrical installation materials
- Type of power supply (TN system, IT system, TT system) and the corresponding connection criteria (classic earthing, protective earthing, necessary additional measures etc.)

If you are not a professional, do not do it yourself, have it performed by a specialist.

5.7 Ingress protection



- The ingress protection rating must be maintained throughout installation and wiring.
- Where applicable, ensure all seals, gaskets, and cable glands are properly fitted and undamaged.
- Improper installation may compromise the protection rating, potentially causing electrical hazards or premature fixture failure, especially in environments with dust or moisture exposure.
- Qualified personnel should verify that installation methods and wiring techniques preserve the fixture's ingress protection rating.

6 Connection

Important:

- Make sure the wires match the polarity markings shown on the terminal connector.
- The connections at both ends of the terminal connectors must match.
- Double check all wires are properly inserted and secured using the terminal screws.
- Sealing rings and tubes must be properly fitted and locking nuts securely fastened.

7 Cleaning and care

Important:

- Do not use aggressive cleaning agents, rubbing alcohol or other chemical solutions. They damage the housing and can cause the product to malfunction.

Wipe the product with a fiber free cloth if needed.

8 Disposal



This symbol must appear on any electrical and electronic equipment placed on the EU market. This symbol indicates that this device should not be disposed of as unsorted municipal waste at the end of its service life.

Owners of WEEE (Waste from Electrical and Electronic Equipment) shall dispose of it separately from unsorted municipal waste.
